## **COMMITTEE ACTIVITY**

During the **week of Jan. 9-13**, committee meetings focused on introduction to processes and procedures, scope of work, and the many new members beginning their first term.

State departments and some advocacy organizations also presented overviews of work, but no action was taken on any bills related to early care and education or school age care.

One item of clarification: the **Senate Human Services Reform Finance and Policy Committee**, chaired by Senator Jim Abeler, will have jurisdiction over the Human Services issues other than health care, which will include child care policy and finance bills.

Senator Abeler also announced that he will appoint a small workgroup, chaired by Senator John Hoffman, to examine issues that impact children 0-5. This group will meet a few times and make recommendations to the larger committee.
