MONDAY, FEB. 6

• Senate E-12 Finance Committee: SF 443 was laid over for possible inclusion in the omnibus bill

TUESDAY, FEB. 7

- House Education Policy Committee: **HF 602** passed and was re-referred to Education Finance
- House Education Finance Committee: HF 890 was heard and public testimony taken
- Senate E-12 Policy Committee: Teacher Licensure evaluation report from the Office of Legislative Auditor
