<b>Scholarship Recipient</b>	<b>Sponsoring Program</b>	<b>T.E.A.C.H. MINNESOTA</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay 10% of the cost of tuition and books and all costs above the 18 semester/27 quarter credit limit</li> <li>• Submit all required paperwork to T.E.A.C.H.</li> <li>• Commit to remaining employed with the sponsoring program for one year after the completion of the contract (“commitment year”)</li> <li>• Successfully complete at least nine semester (13 quarter) credits to receive a bonus from T.E.A.C.H.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay 5% of the cost of tuition and books up to the 18 semester/27 quarter credit limit</li> <li>• Provide up to 3 hours a week of paid time off to scholarship recipient each semester/quarter</li> <li>• Guarantee a \$250 bonus or 2% raise to the scholarship recipient (above and beyond any normal raise) at the end of each contract*</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay 85% of the cost of books and tuition not to exceed the 18 semester/27 quarter credit limit</li> <li>• Provide a travel stipend; \$60 per semester and \$45 per quarter**</li> <li>• Reimburse the sponsoring program for release time up to 48 hours per semester or 36 hours per quarter at a rate of \$7.50/hour **</li> <li>• Award a \$250 bonus if the scholarship recipient completes nine or 13 credits</li> </ul>

Each contract is for one year, covering three semesters or four quarters. For example, if you applied by the November 1 deadline your contract would include the spring, summer and fall semesters (or winter, spring, summer and fall quarters). The 18 semester (27 quarter) credit maximum includes credits paid for by other sources of financial aid, such as the Pell Grant (excluding loans).

*\* If you are housed in a public school or operate under a contract which impacts your ability to provide a raise, bonus or release time, please contact a T.E.A.C.H. counselor about other options.*

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay 15% of the cost of tuition and books and all costs above the 18 semester/27 quarter credit limit</li> <li>• Submit all required paperwork to T.E.A.C.H.</li> <li>• Commit to working under current family child care licensed for one year after the completion of the contract (“commitment year”)</li> <li>• Successfully complete at least nine semester (13 quarter) credits to receive a bonus from T.E.A.C.H.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pay 85% of the cost of books and tuition not to exceed the 18 semester/27 quarter credit limit</li> <li>• Provide a travel stipend of \$60 per semester or \$45 per quarter*</li> <li>• Reimburse the scholarship recipient for sub time at \$160 per semester or \$120 per quarter *</li> <li>• Award a \$300 bonus if the scholarship recipient completes nine semester or 13 quarter credits</li> </ul>
