



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE / April 3, 2018

OVERVIEW

This was **the second deadline** week at the Legislature. For bills to continue moving through the process, they needed to receive a hearing in both the appropriate House and Senate Policy Committee by **Thursday, March 29.** There is a list of bills that met this deadline (including those awaiting floor votes) later in this update.

A reminder that the Legislature is on their **Legislative Recess from March 30 to April 8.** Since there will be no Legislative action to report during this time, this weekly update will resume on Tuesday, April 17.
