Wages increased an average of 14% for associate degrees, and 11% for bachelor's degrees



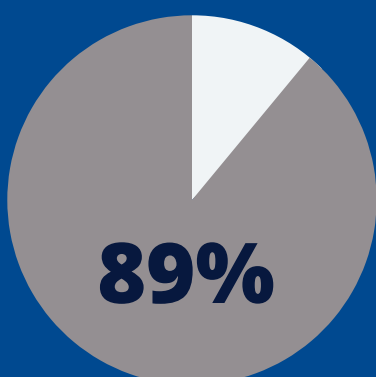
On average, associate degree recipients completed 15 credits; bachelor's degree recipients completed 17



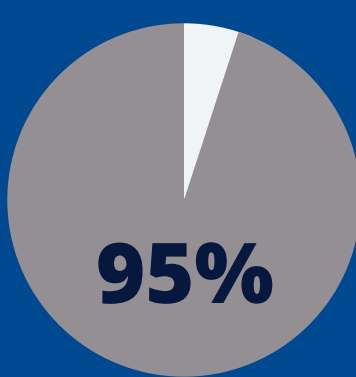
Average turnover rates were 5% for those with associate degrees and 6% for those with bachelor's degrees

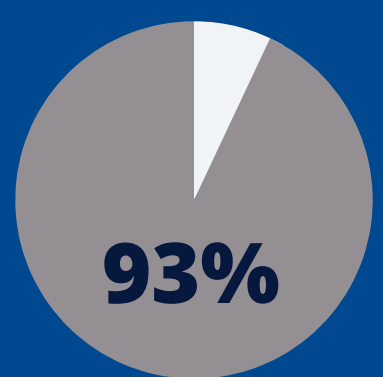
