



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE, February 16, 2021

Welcome to the fifth Child Care Aware Legislative Update of the 2021 Legislative session. This narrative update, along with our Bill Tracker, will be posted each Tuesday (reflecting activity through the previous Friday) on the Child Care Aware of Minnesota Website.

OVERVIEW

As expected, the pace of bill hearings picked up this week with several bills heard in committee and re-referred to additional committees with shared jurisdiction or laid over for possible inclusion in the committee's omnibus bill.

Bills reflecting the Governor's proposed change items were introduced this week on the floor and will likely begin the hearing process in the next week or two.

- Friday, April 9 Committees must act favorably on major appropriation and finance bills.
