### **CDA®** Training Requirement Checklist

Prior to determining which CDA<sup>®</sup> type to apply for or registering for courses or a learning community, it is highly recommended that you contact our Workforce Advising Coordinator, <u>Christy Berg</u>. Our Workforce Advising Coordinator can review your Learning Record to determine what progress you may have already made towards fulfilling CDA<sup>®</sup> training requirements.

There are several Anytime Learning (self-paced) courses available through Eager-to-Learn in each of the eight CDA<sup>®</sup> subject areas. You are required to complete at least 10 hours in each area. After talking with our Workforce Advising Coordinator, use this guide as a resource to find and track CDA<sup>®</sup> training completion.

**Please Note:** Eager-to-Learn does not provide refunds for Anytime Learning course registrations. We recommend you reach out to our Workforce Advising Coordinator and/or review your Learning Record prior to registering to avoid paying registration for unnecessary courses.

#### How to access your Learning Record in Develop:

- 1. Go to developtoolmn.org and click "Login" in the upper right corner
- 2. Enter in your email and Develop password
- 3. Once you are logged in, scroll to the bottom of the page until you see "Application Reports"
- 4. Click on "Knowledge and Competency Framework Learning Record."

From here, your Learning Record can be printed and/or saved for your records.

To show proof of your professional education, you must provide transcripts, certificates, or training verification letters (originals or copies) in your Professional Portfolio. A Professional Development Specialist will review your documentation at the time of your CDA<sup>®</sup> verification visit.
