

Technical Assistance Data for Child Care Stabilization Grants

The American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law in March 2021. It provided Minnesota with additional funds to help stabilize the child care industry as the state recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic. The <u>Minnesota legislature created Minnesota's Child Care Stabilization Grant</u> <u>Program</u>, which began in June 2021 and will last until June 2023. Child Care Aware of Minnesota has been the sole technical assistance provider for applicants and recipients of the Child Care Stabilization Base Grants. Since November 2021 (the earliest month data is available), our team has provided almost 25,000 minutes (417 hours) of technical assistance through more than 5,000 phone calls. We have also provided technical assistance through email, receiving 5,193 email requests for help.
