



# **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE | JANUARY 17, 2023**

#### **OVERVIEW**

The pace picked up at the Capitol this week with the passage of tax conformity legislation, which Gov. Tim Walz signed into law on January 12.

With this bill, any state taxes that reference either federal adjusted gross income or federal taxable income will be altered to align with seven federal acts, including the CARES Act, the American Rescue Plan Act, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, and the Inflation Reduction Act.

Updates at the state level mostly relate to additions, subtractions, deductions, and credits that would be changed because of a new definition of federal adjusted gross income or federal taxable income. Included among them are the dependent care credit and working family credit.

### COMMITTEE/FLOOR ACTIVITY

Here are the committee discussions that took place during the week of January 9-13

- The **House Children and Families Committee** met to consider HF 150 Pinto, which modifies Child care stabilization base grants and appropriates money.
- The **House Tax Committee** heard HF 31 Gomez, which modifies individual income and corporate franchise provisions and provides federal tax provisions conformity. The bill was adopted as amended and sent to the House Ways and Means Committee.
- The **Senate Tax Committee** heard SF 25 Rest, which modifies individual income and corporate franchise provisions and provides federal tax provisions conformity. The bill was amended and recommended to pass.

### **BILL INTRODUCTIONS**
