

Participation Agreement

Family Child Care

The TEACH Early Childhood® Minnesota scholarship program offered through Child Care Aware of Minnesota requires the participation of each scholarship recipient. By signing this agreement, the family child care scholarship applicant agrees to all of the following:

- Pay TEACH for 10 percent of the cost of tuition and books. This cost will be calculated after all other financial aid award(s) (excepting loans) have been applied. TEACH scholarships cover approved courses the recipient is enrolled in during the scholarship year, up to 18 semester (28 quarter) credits.
- Submit all required paperwork (including grades) by established deadlines and pay all bills in a timely manner.
- Communicate regularly with TEACH coordinator (e.g. class changes, employment status changes, etc.).
- Successfully complete the minimum required 9 semester (12 quarter) credits during the scholarship year to receive a TEACH bonus.
- Commit to working under current family child care license for one additional year beyond the scholarship year.
- Remain working under current family child care license for a minimum of 20 hours per week during the scholarship year.
- Pay the college directly for any tuition exceeding the annual credit limit or courses that are not approved by the TEACH program.
